Juneau. . . The Alaska Department of Fish and Game (ADF&G), announces the Joint, Northern, and Southern Southeast Regional Planning Teams fall 2019 meeting will be held at the above time and place. The Regional Planning Teams (RPT) consist of representatives of salmon fishing gear groups and ADF&G personnel. RPTs were established by the Commissioner of ADF&G for the purpose of development and amendment of comprehensive salmon plans; making recommendations concerning private non-profit hatchery permits and permit alteration requests (PARs); and making recommendations concerning the allocation of enhanced salmon throughout Southeast Alaska. This meeting is open to the public.

The Northern RPT will review a NSRAA permit alteration request (PAR) to add Southeast Cove as a release site for 700 thousand Chinook salmon currently released at Hidden Falls. The Southern RPT has no action items on the agenda. The Joint RPT will discuss allocation of hatchery-produced salmon and possibly other related topics.
